# Participant Release and Waiver of Liability

This Release and Waiver of Liability (“Release”) is executed by the individual signing below (“Participant”) in favor of Sheridan Community Land Trust (“SCLT”), a Land Trust existing under the laws of the State of Wyoming and each of its elected and appointed officials, employees, officers, agents, successors, assignees, and volunteers.

The Participant desires to participate in an event on trails maintained by SCLT. The Participant understands that their event may include possible exposure to hazardous conditions, or other circumstances that could result in injury, and freely executes this Release without duress under the following terms:

**Release and Waiver.** Participant AGREES TO HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFY, RELEASE, AND FOREVER DISCHARGE SCLT AND ALL OF ITS TRUSTEES, OFFICERS, AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, AND VOLUNTEERS FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL FUTURE CLAIMS, DEMANDS, OR CAUSES OF ACTION, ON ACCOUNT OF DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY, OR PERSONAL INJURY, OR DEATH, WHICH MAY RESULT FROM Participant’S PARTICIPATION IN THIS ACTIVITY.
