## Student Internship Opportunity

### Non-Profit Host: Sheridan Community Land Trust

The Sheridan Community Land Trust (SCLT) works to preserve our heritage of open spaces, healthy rivers and creeks, working ranches, wildlife habitat, and vibrant history, while expanding recreational opportunities to connect people with the places they love. They work with landowners to conserve open space, wildlife habitat and agriculture. The SCLT tells local history through walks, tours and online experiences. They also create and maintain hiking, biking, equestrian and paddling trails.

### Intern Job Description:

This opportunity with the Sheridan Community Land Trust will provide hands-on experience researching, developing, and implementing a community awareness program for a non-profit organization. The intern will work with the History Program Manager to establish a community storytelling program by following the StoryCorps DIY curriculum, a set of self-paced online courses designed to help non-profits embed storytelling into their work. After completing the courses which the intern determines relevant to the project, they will lead implementation of the storytelling program using the insights and using the best practices they learned. The goal is to create a sustainable system for recording and archiving local stories. This will help advance innovative historic preservation goals for SCLT and the local community.

The Homer A. & Mildred Scott Foundation Internship is a unique opportunity for Sheridan College students to gain practicum experience closely related to their field of study while the participating non-profit organization is able to move their mission forward with the aid of the student intern.
